### Product Description

To be used for positioning and applying pressure, e.g. during painting and sandblasting.

#### Material

##### Body

- Steel, zinc-plated by galvanization

##### Spring

- Steel, blackened

##### Pin

- Steel, case-hardened, zinc-plated by galvanization

#### Assembly

Lateral plungers are installed by screwing in by means of a mounting tool.

Formula for calculating the center distance for the mounting hole:

$$l_0 = z/2 + w + x,$$

$l_0$  = center distance,

$y$  = workpiece height,

$w$  = workpiece length,

$x$  = coordinate dimension,

$s$  = stroke,

$z$  = stop diameter

Calculation dimension  $x$ :

$y$  greater than or equal to  $l_2 - d_2/2$ ,

then  $x = d_2/2 - s$

or

$y$  smaller than  $l_2 - d_2/2$ ,

then  $x = d_2/2 - s - [(l_2 - d_2/2 - y) * 0,123]$

#### Characteristic

Version standard spring load = spring from steel, blackened
